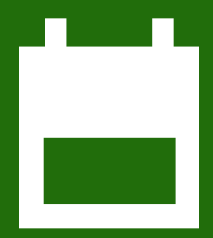

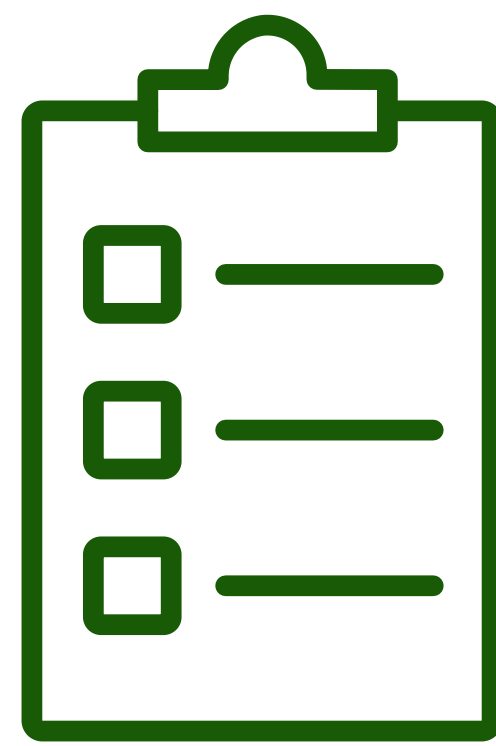

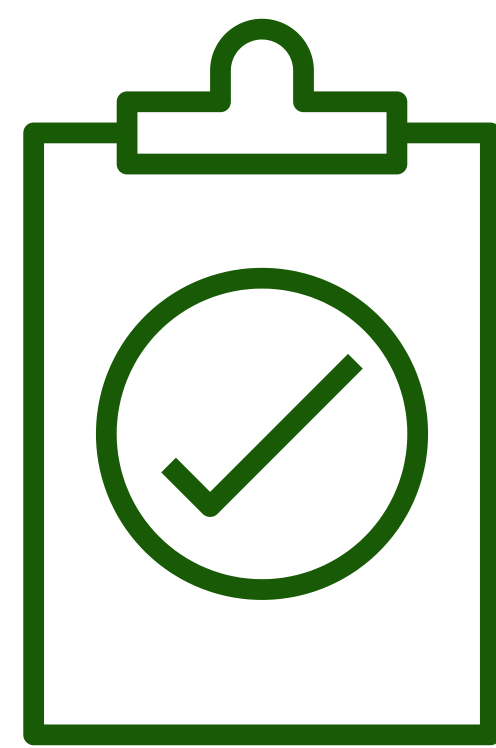

Symposium Goals



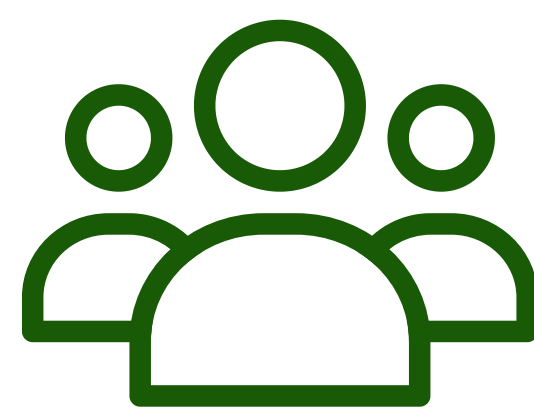
- To provide an opportunity for scientists to **share what they are learning or hoping to learn from recent westside Oregon fires.**
